



# Memory Verse

BIBLICAL BACKGROUND: In the Old Testament, the Hebrew word is "Sheol." It means "pit or grave," and is sometimes translated "hell." The primary meaning is a place were someone goes when he or she dies, which can be the grave, or the afterlife. It became the basis for the Greek word, "hades." It also means the "place of the undead," both righteous and unrighteous. 2 other Greek words refer to hell in the New Testament: Gehenna and Tartarus. Gehenna is based on an area in Israel that was called the Valley of Hinnom from the Hebrew Gihinnom and comes into English as Gehenna. Tartarus, is used once in the Bible: 2 Peter 2:4, referring to sinful angels.
