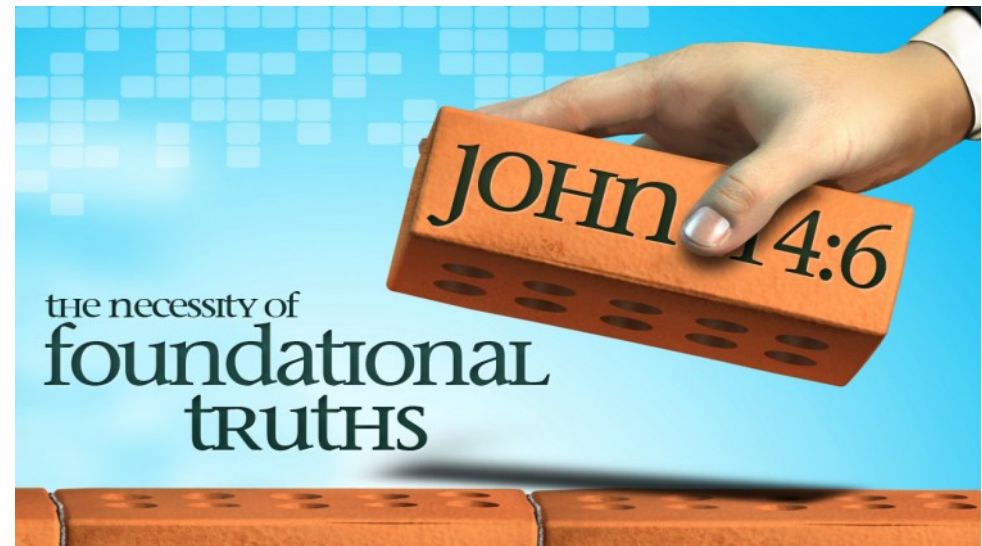

BIBLICAL BACKGROUND: In the Old Testament, the Hebrew word is "*Sheol*." It means "*pit or grave*," and is sometimes translated "*hell*." The primary meaning is a place where someone goes when he or she dies, which can be the grave, or the afterlife. It became the basis for the Greek word, "*hades*." It also means the "*place of the undead*," both righteous and unrighteous. 2 other Greek words refer to hell in the New Testament: *Gehenna* and *Tartarus*. *Gehenna* is based on an area in Israel that was called the Valley of *Hinnom* from the Hebrew *Gihinnom* and comes into English as *Gehenna*. *Tartarus*, is used once in the Bible: *2 Peter 2:4*, referring to sinful angels.
