No one like him -

Genuinely concerned -

"A more literal translation... "His proven character you know." The noun rendered here as "proven character" (dokimē) refers to the quality of having remained faithful through difficult circumstances. C. Philippians 2:25-27 - Epaphroditus's .

Fellow worker -

Fellow soldier - Exegetical Guide to the Greek New Testament, Philippians: [This] "elicits the image of "a wounded comrade-in-arms, who is being sent back home for rest"... Originally a military term describing those who fight side by side, [this] ... speaks of conflict or persecution, possibly even imprisonment, that Epaphroditus faced with Paul, as they labored together in the gospel... Martial imagery would have resonated strongly at Philippi, which had been established as a colony of veterans. Paul intends συστρατιώτηναs [systratiotenas] a "term of honor"..., since Roman generals used the term to portray their soldiers as equal to their commander in chief..."
