The Preachers Commentary Series: "The hatred of God is not an irrational outburst, but God's moral response to our immorality, or, here, to those who do evil. The phrase "*workers of iniquity*" appears often in the individual psalms of lament. As a rule it means groups of people who scheme together, boast together, and use words as their evil weapons (see Ps. 64:2-4). This thought is picked up in verse 9." *Psalms 1-72* (Vol. 13, p. 56).
