Gotquestions.org: “Jesus quoted some of the imprecatory psalms during His earthly ministry. In [John 15:25](#), Jesus quotes [Psalm 35:19](#) and [69:4](#). Paul also quoted an imprecatory prayer in [Romans 11:9–10](#), which is a quote of [Psalm 69:22–23](#). Since Jesus and Paul quoted verses from these imprecatory psalms, it proves those psalms were inspired by God and counters any allegation that they were sinful or selfish prayers of revenge.”
