- 1. Because the Gospel is God’s, He brings salvation only through it. Romans 5, Romans 3:23. Genesis 6:5, Ephesians 2:1-3**
- 2. It is truth: Galatians 2:5, 14, Ephesians 1:13, Colossians 1:5**
- 3. It is hidden from those who do not believe: 2 Corinthians 4:3-4**
- 4. Believed by faith: Acts 20:21. While the Holy Spirit must move in us, we are**
- 5. A confession of Jesus as Lord: Romans 10:15-16, Philippians 2:11**
- 6. By God’s grace through faith: Ephesians 2:8-9**
- 7. It is a mystery: Ephesians 6:18-20**
- 8. It is what we have fellowship in: Philippians 1:5**
- 9. It comes in word, power, the Holy Spirit and assurance or confidence: 1 Thessalonians 1:5**
- 10. Through it, God imputes the righteousness of Christ to us: 2 Corinthians 5:21**
