A. Adoption in Ancient Rome

Adoption (Dictionary): The act or process of adopting a child; the act or process of beginning to use something new or different; the act or process of giving official acceptance or approval to something.; Adoption (Bible): Adoption, as a son into the divine family; to await eagerly; foreordain, predetermine; a son, descendent.; Most of the time when we hear or read about ...

B. Adoption in the New Testament

Romans 8:14-17

One usage of "adoption" is verse 15, connected to the word "heir." Other usages of adoption are Romans 8:23, 9:4 (Israel), Galatians 4:5 and Ephesians 1:5.

C. Adoption and the Christian

- 1. Losing all rights to the old family and gaining all right of the new family as a fully legitimate son. 1st John 3:1-3. Romans 8:23**
- 2. An heir to the father's estate. Galatians 3:26-4:7, Colossians 1:9-12**
- 3. The old life is completely wiped out. Colossians 1:13-14, Colossians 2:13-15**
- 4. We become absolutely the son of the new father 1st John 3:1a**
- 5. Because we are in a new family, we are to love one another. 1st John 3:16-18**
