A. The Probability of Persecution

It can come from *within families* and be minimal to severe.

There is *government persecution*. This can range from minimal to severe.

Persecution is worldwide and it depends on where one lives, who is in authority and, how faithful one is to Christ that determines the type and level of persecution.




























Prayer
