

Victory: The Book of Galatians

Galatians was written to teach us how to experience true freedom in Christ through victorious living. The key to our victory is found in the crucified Christ and in the power of the Holy Spirit. This series teaches how to discover the fullness of victory God intends for all believers.

¹ O foolish Galatians! Who has bewitched you? It was before your eyes that Jesus Christ was publicly portrayed as crucified. ² Let me ask you only this: Did you receive the Spirit by works of the law or by hearing with faith? ³ Are you so foolish? Having begun by the Spirit, are you now being perfected by the flesh?" Galatians 3:1-3 (ESV)

1. FAITH MAKES YOU _____ WITH GOD.

²⁴ So then, the law was our guardian until Christ came, in order that we might be justified by faith." Galatians 3:24 (ESV)

παιδαγωγός = paidagōgos = guardian, leader, guide

¹⁵ For I do not understand my own actions. For I do not do what I want, but I do the very thing I hate ... ¹⁸ For I know that nothing good dwells in me, that is, in my flesh. For I have the desire to do what is right, but not the ability to carry it out. ¹⁹ For I do not do the good I want, but the evil I do not want is what I keep on doing."
Romans 7:15, 18-19 (ESV)

²¹ Is the law then contrary to the promises of God? Certainly not! For if a law had been given that could give life, then righteousness would indeed be by the law. ²² But the Scripture imprisoned everything under sin, so that the promise by faith in Jesus Christ might be given to those who believe." Galatians 3:21-22 (ESV)

²⁵ But now that faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian," Galatians 3:25 (ESV)

¹⁰ For if while we were enemies we were reconciled to God by the death of his Son, much more, now that we are reconciled, shall we be saved by his life." Romans 5:10 (ESV)

⁸ And the Scripture, foreseeing that God would justify the Gentiles by faith, preached the gospel beforehand to Abraham, saying, "In you shall all the nations be blessed." ⁹ So then, those who are of faith are blessed along with Abraham, the man of faith. Galatians 3:8-9 (ESV)

²⁹ And if you are Christ's, then you are Abraham's offspring, heirs according to promise." Galatians 3:29 (ESV)

² And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. ³ I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." Genesis 12:2-3 (ESV)
