

Victory: The Book of Galatians

Galatians was written to teach us how to experience true freedom in Christ through victorious living. The key to our victory is found in the crucified Christ and in the power of the Holy Spirit. This series teaches how to discover the fullness of victory God intends for all believers.

¹⁶ I say then, walk by the Spirit and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh.” Galatians 5:16 (ESV)

1. FILTER YOUR _____.

⁷ You were running the race so well. Who has held you back from following the truth? ⁸ It certainly isn't God, for he is the one who called you to freedom. ⁹ This false teaching is like a little yeast that spreads through the whole batch of dough!” Galatians 5:7-9 (NLTse)

¹⁰ I am trusting the Lord to keep you from believing false teachings. God will judge that person, whoever he is, who has been confusing you.” Galatians 5:10 (NLTse)

¹² I just wish that those troublemakers who want to mutilate you by circumcision would mutilate themselves.” Galatians 5:12 (NLTse)

¹² Dear brothers and sisters, I plead with you to live as I do in freedom from these things, for I have become like you Gentiles—free from those laws. You did not mistreat me when I first preached to you.” Galatians 4:12 (NLTse)

2. LOOK FOR OPPORTUNITIES TO _____ OTHERS.

¹³ For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love. ¹⁴ For the whole law can be summed up in this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." Galatians 5:13-14 (NLTse)

² Share each other's burdens, and in this way obey the law of Christ.” Galatians 6:2 (NLTse)

¹⁰ Therefore, whenever we have the opportunity, we should do good to everyone—especially to those in the family of faith.”

Galatians 6:10 (NLTse)

3. _____ ON YOUR FEET.

⁵ Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit.” Romans 8:5 (NLTse)

¹⁹ When you follow the desires of your sinful nature, the results are very clear: sexual immorality, impurity, lustful pleasures, ²⁰ idolatry, sorcery, hostility, quarreling, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambition, dissension, division, ²¹ envy, drunkenness, wild parties, and other sins like these. Let me tell you again, as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God.”

²² But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³ gentleness, and self-control. There is no law against these things!”

²⁴ Those who belong to Christ Jesus have nailed the passions and desires of their sinful nature to his cross and crucified them there.”
