
**Genesis 17:7-8**

## A. Covenants

### 1. What is a Covenant?

It is **not a contract**, but an agreement, treaty or **binding promise** *between 2 or more parties*. A covenant is as secure as the integrity of those making it.

# A. Covenants

## 2. Types

### a. Unilateral and Unconditional

1 party does something *apart from anyone or anything else*. This is **regardless** of what another person does, or does not do, and *no matter what occurs this covenant still stands*.

## 2. Types

### b. Bilateral and Conditional

This is the *agreement between 2 or more parties*. 1 person/group will do something and the other person/group will do something. If 1 party breaks the covenant, *consequences* or “*curses*” occur and it becomes void if desired.

## A. Covenants

### 3. Established in Blood

The Hebrew root word “*berit*” means, “to cut.” Greek is “*diatheke*.” You “*cut a covenant*.”

*New Unger’s Bible Dictionary*, p. 260,  
“*Ceremonies*.”

There was often a “*sign*” for covenants, something *visible* to represent it.

## **B. Noahic Covenant - *Genesis 6:18, 8:20-22, 9:8-17***

### **1. Unilateral and Unconditional**

The sign to the covenant is the *rainbow* and it's an everlasting and unconditional covenant (*Genesis 9:15-16*). Neither Noah nor his family did anything to merit this, but God did it.

## B. Noahic Covenant - *Genesis 6:18, 8:20-22, 9:8-17*

### 2. Established with Mankind Around 2500-3000 B.C.

Established in blood in *Genesis 8:20-22*. This was after God told Noah He would establish a covenant with him, *6:18*. These *sacrifices were given* just over a **year after** the flood began! The sign of the *covenant was/is* \_\_\_\_\_. God “set His bow in the sky.” God *promised not to judge the world again by water*.

## C. Abrahamic Covenant - *Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-21, 17:1-22*

### 1. Unilateral and Unconditional


God took the initiative, told Abram *He would do this* and introduced the covenant in *Genesis 12:1-3*. *God sovereignly chose to do it!* The covenant was either *officially made or reaffirmed* in *Genesis 15*. This is where *Abraham kills animals*, and places half on one side and half on the other.



## **C. Abrahamic Covenant - *Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-21, 17:1-22***

### **2. Established with Abraham and His Descendents about 2100/2000B.C.**

Abram lived in Ur of the Chaldees. He wasn't seeking God, but *heard God speak* (*Genesis 12:1-3*). God *introduced and established* His covenant with him.



## **C. Abrahamic Covenant - *Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-21, 17:1-22***

### **3. Consisted of 4 Parts**

#### **a. Nation – *12:2, 17:4, 7-8***

*It is through Israel that Messiah came!*

#### **b. Divine Blessing and Protection – *12:3***

The Egyptians, Babylonians, Persians, Medes, Rome, Greece, etc. *are all history!* **The Jews still exist after more than 4000 years.**

## C. Abrahamic Covenant - *Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-21, 17:1-22*

### 3. Consisted of 4 Parts

#### b. Divine Blessing and Protection – **12:3**

The *sign of the covenant* was \_\_\_\_\_:

*Genesis 17:1-13*. The symbol didn't come until *after* God established the covenant!

\_\_\_\_\_ was the sign to the Jewish nation. It wasn't new to the culture of that day.

## C. Abrahamic Covenant - *Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-21, 17:1-22*

### 3. Consisted of 4 Parts

#### b. Divine Blessing and Protection – *12:3*

The *sign of the covenant* was circumcision:

*Genesis 17:1-13*. The symbol didn't come until *after* God established the covenant!

Circumcision was the sign to the Jewish nation. It wasn't new to the culture of that day.

## C. Abrahamic Covenant - *Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-21, 17:1-22*

### 3. Consisted of 4 Parts

c. The Land – *12:1-3, 15:1-6, 18-21, 17:8 Genesis 15:18-21*. It speaks of the land! *Joshua 21:43-45* shows it's immediate fulfillment for the 12 tribes of Israel. However, not all the land God promised Abraham was *taken by the Israelites*. The **complete fulfillment** comes in the *Millennium*.

## **C. Abrahamic Covenant - *Genesis 12:1-3, 15:1-21, 17:1-22***

### **3. Consisted of 4 Parts**

**d. The Seed - Fulfilled in Christ – *15:1-21, 17:2-7, 22:15-18, Galatians 3:7-9, 16***

The covenant refers to the birth of Abraham's son, *Isaac*, in his old age, and extended beyond that. Isaac was promised in *15:1-18*, reaffirmed in *17:2-7*, but wasn't born until many years later.

## D. Mosaic Covenant – *Exodus 19:1-9, 24:3-12*

### 1. Bilateral and Conditional

God told Moses what He would do. Israel was to obey God in the Torah or Teaching, and the 613 Laws and regulations in **this covenant**.

### 2. Established with Israel Around 1450B.C.

God gave the Mosaic covenant to him to *give to the children of Israel*. They promised to fulfill what was said in it: *Exodus 19:1-9*.

**D. Mosaic Covenant** – *Exodus 19:1-9, 24:3-12*

**3. Pointed to Christ** – **Galatians 3:13-25,**  
**4:21-5:6**

The Mosaic covenant was an addition to the Abrahamic covenant because of transgressions and pointed to Jesus.

*Galatians 3:13-25, and 2 Timothy 3:14-15!*

## **E. Davidic Covenant – 2 Samuel 7:4-16, Jeremiah 33:14-26**

### **1. Unilateral and Unconditional**

This is an addition to the Abrahamic and Mosaic covenants. God narrowed down the individual to whom the promised Messiah King would be born. God said **He would do this!**

**E. Davidic Covenant** – *2 Samuel 7:4-16, Jeremiah 33:14-26*

**2. Established with David and His Descendents Around 1000B.C.**

The Davidic covenant included part of the Mosaic covenant to obey what God stated: *1 Kings 9:1-9*. It was immediately fulfilled when *Solomon provided sacrifices to sanctify the Temple in 1 Kings 8:62-66*.

## E. Davidic Covenant – *2 Samuel 7:4-16, Jeremiah 33:14-26*

**3. Fulfilled in Christ - Isaiah 9:6-7, Matthew 1:1, Luke 1:32-33, Acts 2:30-32, Hebrews 1:5**  
The immediate context of *2 Samuel 7* refers to Solomon, but the ultimate fulfillment is in Jesus. The *religious leaders* rejected their King and crucified Him (*Acts 2:36*). Yet, *because of God's unilateral and unconditional covenant with Abraham and David*, Jesus **will** sit upon a throne.

**F. New Covenant – *Isaiah 49:7-9, Jeremiah 31:31-34, Matthew 26:26-30***

**1. Unilateral and Unconditional**  
**Isaiah 49:7-9.**

**2. Foretold in the Old Testament**  
**Jeremiah 31:31-34. Ezekiel 37**

God said He would *establish this covenant with them* and write the Law upon their hearts. As with the Abrahamic covenant, it is *entered by faith!*

**F. New Covenant – *Isaiah 49:7-9, Jeremiah 31:31-34, Matthew 26:26-30***

**3. Built on the Abrahamic, Mosaic and Davidic Covenants - Hebrews 7:11-10:25**

It is understood that Jesus discussed the New Covenant during the Last Supper. He said it was *established in His blood, a reference to His crucifixion*. The New *doesn't disannul* the Abrahamic or Davidic covenants.
